

What Really Matters - Electronic Master Patient Index (eMPI)

The eMPI is a patient focused scheduling tool developed by District Nurses to enhance patient experience & patient safety in Stockport

Aim

To improve the experience of housebound patients receiving District Nurse (DN) care in Stockport by:

1. Increase patient choice of time of DN visit
2. Improve patient safety by reducing the number of missed visits & medication errors due to allocation errors
3. Using 'lean' principles to develop an efficient IT based patient allocation system in conjunction with frontline DNs

Average Number of Quarterly Missed Visits / Medication Errors



Patient Involvement

Service user input into development of visit time band
92% of patient now have a scheduled visit time slot
Working with local LINK to gain impartial feedback



Outcomes

Since eMPI 'go live' :

- ✓ 5800 episodes of care have been scheduled & delivered
- ✓ NO MISSED VISITS!
- ✓ On average nurses save 2.5 hours of admin time per week
- ✓ The pilot is set to be rolled out across 19 DN teams
