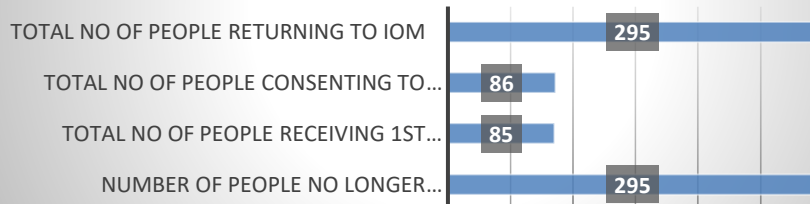

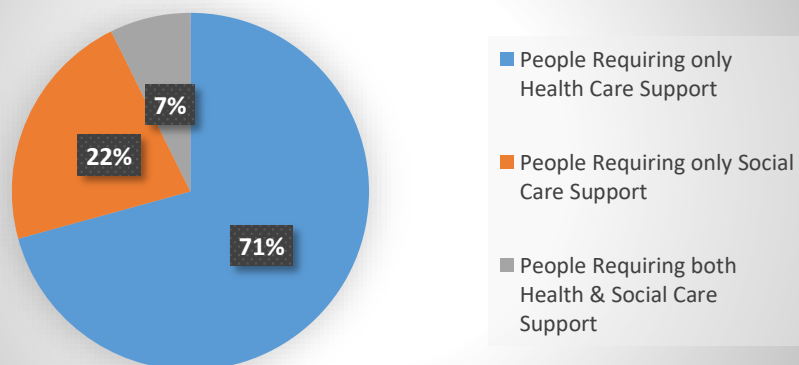


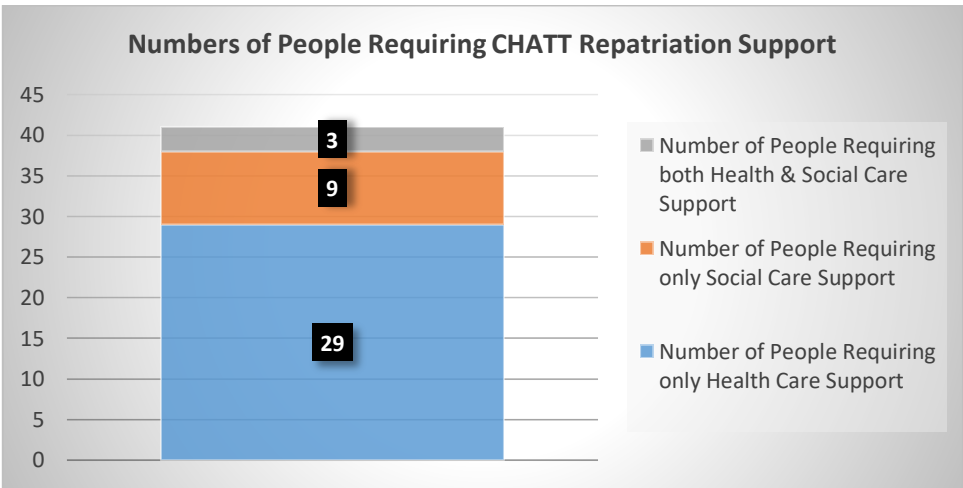
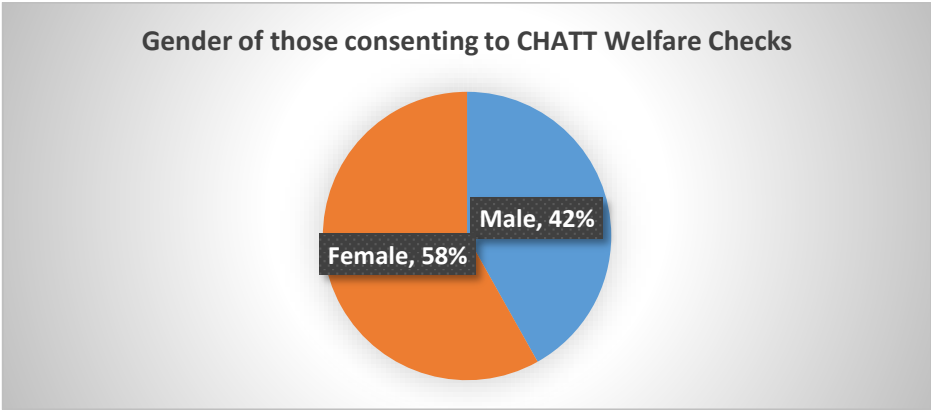
### CHATT Repatriation Cumulative Data % Welfare Check Data



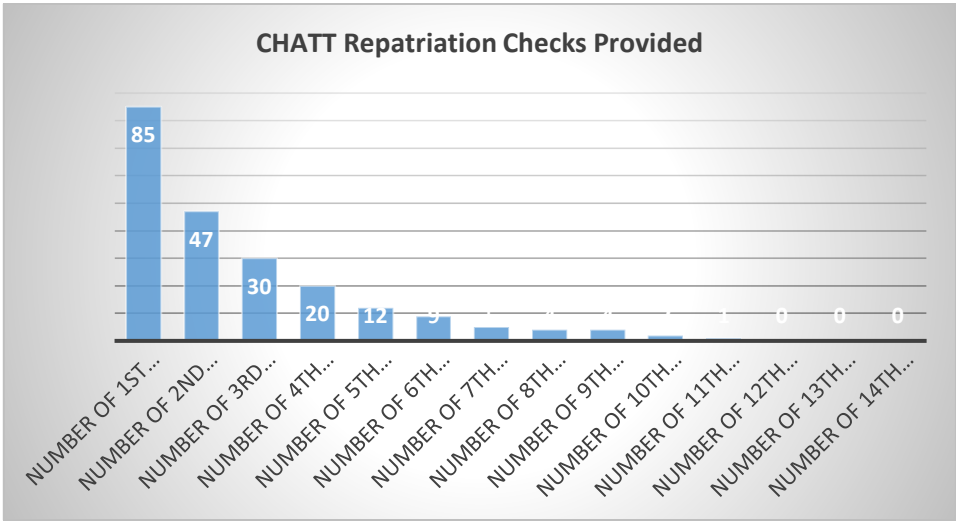
After repeated attempts one person who consented to checks, did not answer calls and the team were not aware of their address so could not complete checks as expected.

### CHATT Repatriation Support Required on date of return



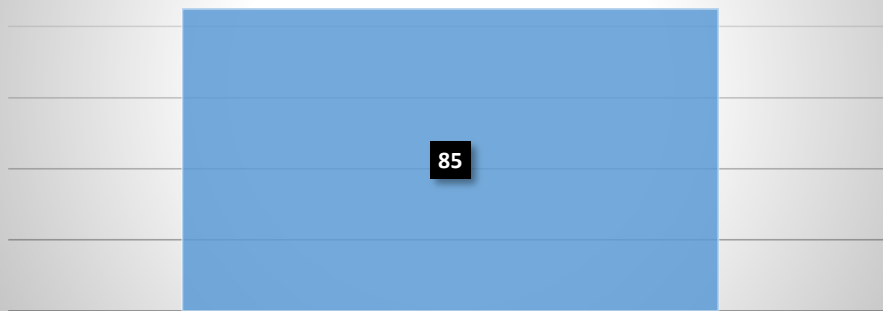


These numbers are people who required actual visits not just a welfare call

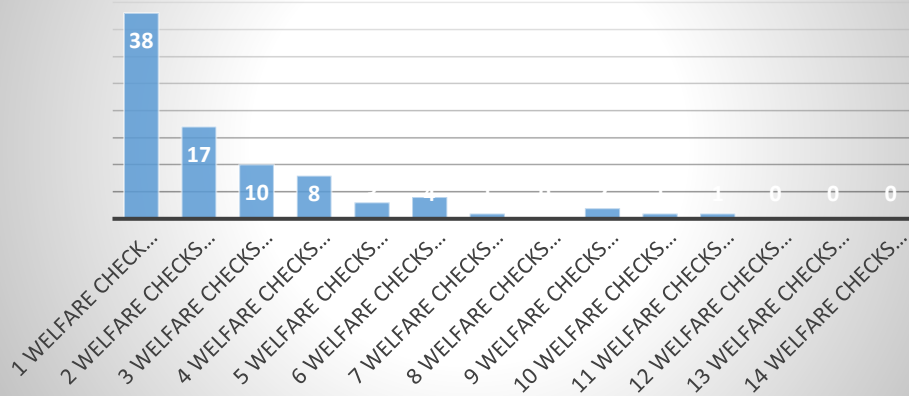


In total 219 welfare checks were provided, the number of calls per person was individual to their need. This graph shows that 60% of people required one or two checks only

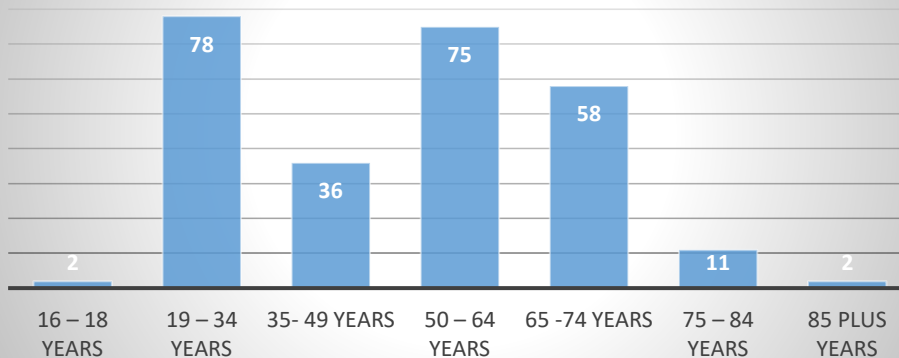
### Total Number of People who have received a CHATT Repatriation Welfare Check



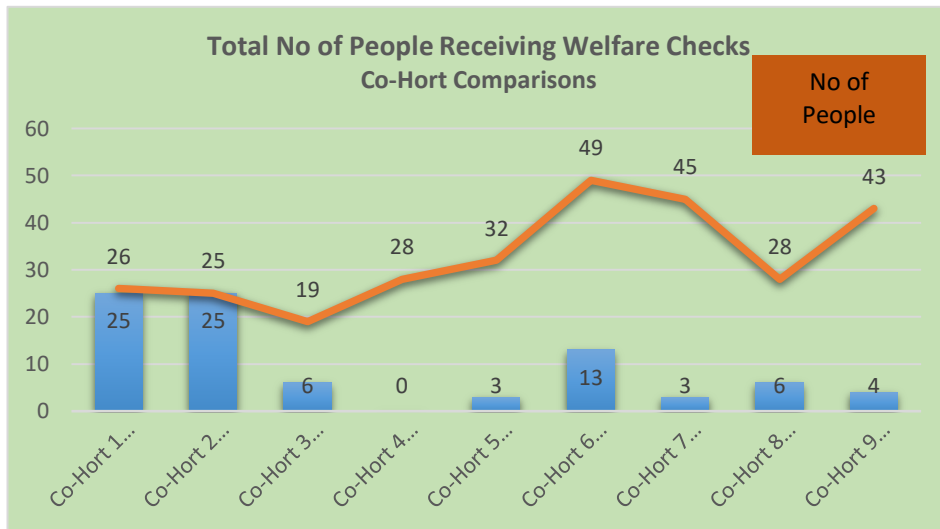
### Number of People broken down into the Number of Welfare Checks they have Received



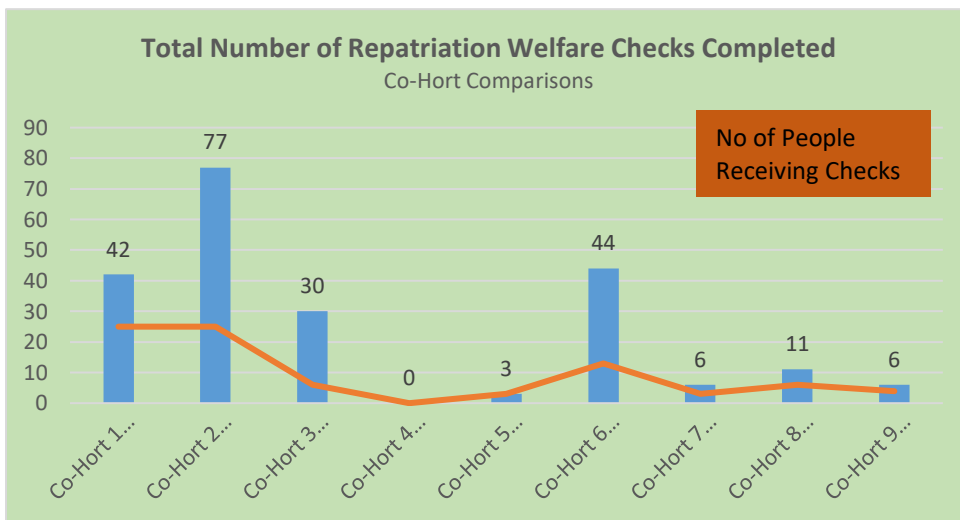
### Repatriation Support Provided by Age Band
