Initial preparations

- Identification of the main beneficiary (Trust, GP surgery, etc.)
- Setting up the QNI account
- Setting up separate budget code/cost centre



Payments

- Funds paid in 3 - 4 instalments
- Receipts/order confirmations/estimates
- Final £500 withheld



Request for payment

1. Email request with the details from the project lead
2. Approval by Sue Boran – PO number to be supplied
3. Request the invoice from finance department (PO mandatory)
4. Invoice sent to the QNI for payment
5. Receipt signed by the project lead
