Support for Students

INSIGHT: Inspiring Students into Research

Funds institutionally-led programmes across 12 regions in England that offer engagement activities and research masters studentships

NIHR Undergraduate Internship Programme

Funds established researchers to host students for 6-8 week paid placements.

Opportunities in NIHR Infrastructure and Schools

Visiting Speaker Award

Opportunity for Academy Members to gain experience in presenting and debating their research findings within a part of the NIHR.

Short Placement Award for Research Collaboration

Supports Academy Members to design and undertake short placements in a part of the NIHR to enhance their careers, skills and networks.

Local Authority Short Placement Award for Research Collaboration

Supports individuals working in local authority settings and Academy Members to undertake short placements to enhance their careers, skills and networks and move between NIHR and Local Authority settings in either direction.

Other capacity building opportunities

Pre-application Support Fund

Support for individuals to prepare an application for NIHR career development funding.

Team Science Camp and Award

An annual initiative designed to support researchers to form new interdisciplinary collaborations and enable research in areas of need

NIHR Incubators

A community-driven approach to address areas/disciplines where there is a need to build research capacity on a national level.

NIHR Senior Investigators

Are among the most prominent and prestigious researchers funded by the NIHR and the most outstanding leaders of people-based research within the NIHR research community.

NIHR Senior Clinical and Practitioner Academic Research Award

Provides up to 5 years of funding for individuals at post-doctoral level to engage in research activities. This award offers applicants flexibility in that they can propose a broad range of research activities to support their career development.

Global Health

Short Placement Award for Research Collaboration

Support for Global Health Academy Members pursuing an academic research career to design and undertake a short bespoke placement.

Global Health Research Cohort Academic Development Award

Offers Training Leads/Programme Directors an opportunity to deliver activities to meet the career development needs of the cohort of Academy Members in their programme.

Global Research Professorships

Funds research leaders to promote effective translation of research and to strengthen research leadership.
